## **Toilet Paper Roll Art For Elementary Students** Presented by the Eastern Iowa Arts Academy

This week's project is simple! Follow the steps below to create a cool piece of art with just a piece of paper, an empty toilet paper roll, a pair of scissors and some paint!



Step 1: Find an empty toilet paper roll. (You could also use an empty paper towel roll! Cut it in half for twice the fun!)

Step 2: Using your scissors (being very careful and with the help of an adult!) cut the end of your toilet paper roll into strips.

Step 3: Using your fingers, spread the strips out so that you can press them down against your paper.

Step 4: Now that the strips are nice and bendy, dip the strips into a little bit of paint. Then press the end of the toilet paper roll to your blank piece of paper like a stamp. When you lift your roll up, you should have something that looks similar to the picture on the left! Use a paint brush or even your fingers, to create a stem and leaves and even a background if you want!
